REGULAR MEETING

CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL Seven commissioners were present for the Clean City Commission meeting a quorum of members was achieved.

1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Regular meeting minutes of February 19, 2015.
Commissioner Russell made a MOTION to APPROVE the February 19, 2015 Meeting Minutes as written. Commissioner Giesbrecht SECONDED and the MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY with a vote of 7-0.

2. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - a. **Discussion of Reusable Bags to Promote Recycling in Kingman.**
The Clean City Commission has purchased reusable bags and has requested matching donations from area grocery stores for distribution to the public to promote recycling. The commission will discuss any progress on this matter. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**

 - b. **Review of Information on Single-Use Plastic Bag Bans.**
The Clean City Commission continues to review research and information from other jurisdictions that have banned or are working on bans of single use plastic bags. The commission will review additional research on this subject. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item including the article “Is it time to toss plastic bags for good?” dated March 19, 2015 in the Kingman Daily Miner. The Commission also discussed Senate Bill 1241 that the Arizona Legislature is considering. Commissioner Giesbrecht made a MOTION for the Clean City Commission to create a letter opposing the SB1241 bill and also recommended that the City of Kingman Council also write a letter opposing this bill. Commissioner Russell SECONDED the MOTION and the MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY with a vote of 7-0.**

 - c. **Update on Publicity Campaign to Promote Weed Control and Discussion of Easement Maintenance.** The commission will receive an update on efforts to publicize city ordinances regarding weed control by property owners in City of Kingman and discuss easement maintenance issues. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**

3. **NEW BUSINESS**
 - a. **Adopt-a-Highway Clean-up.**
The commission will discuss plans for their Adopt-a-Highway clean-up on April 11, 2015. **The Clean City Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**

b. Airway Avenue Clean-up.

The CCC has proposed a schedule with Smith's and Wal-Mart to clean-up a portion of Airway Avenue. Any progress on this project will be discussed. **The Clean City Commission discussed the Airway clean up schedule and response from the letters sent to the merchants. The Commission discussed this item with no action taken.**

c. Community Clean-up Discussion.

The commission will discuss the outcome of the March 14, 2015 community clean-up and will begin discussing plans for the next clean-up on May 9, 2015. **The Clean City Commission discussed the March 14, 2015 clean up with no action taken.**
