events and projects of mutual concern. Direction may be provided to staff concerning future coordination and agenda items. No action will be taken.

b. Discussion and/or possible action regarding the 2016 Badges of Courage basketball game

The commission will discuss the possibility of participating in the planning and hosting of the 2016 Badges of Courage charity basketball game. This annual event has traditionally been planned and hosted by the commission in conjunction with the Lee Williams High School Student Council.
